NOTE: This rally is for T@B, T@G, T@DA, and T@B400 trailers built or sold under the Dutchman, Little Guy, Pleasant Valley and NuCamp brand names with owners residing in the Northern California area. (Some **long-term** supporters not meeting these parameters have been grandfathered in.)

Location: Olema Campground. 10155 CA Hwy 1, Olema, CA 94950. www.olemacampground.net

Rally Dates: Thursday afternoon October 3 - Sunday morning October 6, 2024

Extra-early registration: This year we have added an extra night at the group rate (arriving Tuesday October 1st) for those of you who would like more time to explore West Marin in all its glories. **This night will only be available to reserve until Saturday February 24th.**

Early registration: For those who would like extra time to set up, visit, or just hang out, the normal pre/post rally stays arriving Wednesday and departing Monday will also be available at the group rate.

Rally Check-in: NEW THIS YEAR

Rally check-in location: **Ironwood Circle, site 157**, where Francine will welcome you.

Rally check in hours: 10:00am-12:00noon, 2:00pm-5:00pm,

- Wednesday PM only
- Thursday AM/PM
- Friday AM only

If you arrive outside of check-in hours, please proceed to your confirmed campsite, and visit Francine during her next open hours. **Do not check in at the Olema Campground Office.**

Please refer to the campground map on the [Olema website](#) to note which campsites are full hookups (*) and which have partial hookups on the passenger side of your trailer (red sites). Please note that all the "K" sites are narrow, and there may not be room for side tent rooms. There is a grassy area behind these sites with picnic tables.

Reservations will be available by online registration only. We keep a robust WAITLIST, so even if your preferred site is taken, please submit a registration and make note of requests in answer to the site request question. See procedure below.

Cost: The group rate includes reservations arriving earliest from Tuesday October 1 – and departing latest by Monday October 7. The group discounted rate is \$50/night for partial hook up and \$56/night for full hook up. The rally fee will be \$40 per campsite, which covers admin and your rally souvenir.

Please read the FAQs section below concerning campground rules for shower/porta potty tents and RV toilet chemical use.

Five nights:	\$320 (Rally \$40 + \$280)
Six nights:	\$376 (Rally + \$336) Tuesday arrival – Monday departure

Payment:

Your Campground Reservation & Rally Fee ***is non-refundable*** and must be paid in full ***within 7 days after you receive confirmation of your site***, to hold your reservation. If payment is not received by then, your site will become available for someone else.

Registrants will receive an auto email confirmation upon submission of their form.

Reservation FAQs

- ***What are the rules for Olema Campground shower/porta potty tents and RV toilet chemical use?*** The campground installed a new sewer treatment system and because of their proximity to the Point Reyes National Seashore and the need for protection of its

watershed, this has triggered California monthly and random monitoring of the ground water for chemical residues. Therefore, please follow these rules:

- No RV toilet chemicals containing ZINC, FORMALDEHYDE OR PHENOLS allowed if using their RV dump station or sewer hook-up.
- Porta-potty/shower tents are allowed for privacy but absolutely NO OUTDOOR SHOWERS are allowed.
- No POOP CHUTES (liners for your poop slinky) are allowed.
- **What happens if full payment is not received within 7 days of receiving site assignment?** If full payment is not received within 7 days, you will lose your site and it will become available.
- **What if the sites all book up?** If the 76 sites are all reserved, interested participants can (i) submit registration form to be added to a WAITLIST for cancelled reservations, (ii) monitor the NorCal T@B Facebook group for anyone seeking someone to take over their reservation, and/or (iii) make a reservation directly with Olema Campground. (see additional information below regarding individual reservations)
- **What if I need to cancel?** If you need to cancel, email norcaloctoberfest@gmail.com and the organizers will first facilitate contacting anyone on the waiting list. Then, if unsuccessful, you should post your reservation “for sale” on our NorCal FB page, the T@b Camping Trailers or T@DA, T@B & T@G Trailer Owners or T@b forum FB pages. Financial arrangements should be between you and whoever takes your spot, but please notify norcaloctoberfest@gmail.com of the updated names on the reservation. No refunds will be available from rally organizers if there is no one on the waiting list.
- **What if I make an individual reservation, will I receive the group discount?** If you are unable to commit to a reservation at this time, Olema Campground may have sites not in our group reservation, however, you would not receive the group discount. Their standard cancellation policies would apply to individual reservations, so you could be on the waiting list for the group reservation at the same time.
- **Why is the fee non-refundable, and why so early?** The 100% nonrefundable deposit is requested to comply with the campground’s group reservation discount policy, and to avoid the organizers needing to “float” the deposit (\$10k+) for many months.
- **How will I know if my reservation request has been received?** You will receive an auto reply acknowledging receipt of your submitted reservation request.
- **I would like to camp next to my friend. Can that be arranged?** Reservation requests will be processed in the order received, however, as always, our best efforts will be made to accommodate site or neighbor requests. You are welcome to list as many requests as you wish on your registration form.
- **Why only 76 sites reserved. Why not more?** Olema Campground is small, and we have reserved all hookup sites.
- **I cannot attend this one. When is the next event?** October 2025, exact dates TBD
